

Lab Manager Position at the Functional Inorganic Materials team

We are looking for a support technician to oversee all the aspects relevant to the maintenance and managing of our experimental facilities and to support the experimental routines of our scientific staff (between 15-20 lab members). We also expect the applicant to procure, maintain and, if applicable, operate lab equipment alongside with monitoring laboratory safety measures.

The position is financed by the European Research Council in the frame of the ERC CONSOLIDATOR GRANT ERC-2021-COG-101043428. Benefits of constant training are offered. Full time position (37 hours/week). 1 year extendable.



Requirements and Expertise:

- Applicants must have at least a FPII degree/Certificate of Higher Education (HNC) related to experimental sciences.
- More than one year experience as a laboratory technician or lab manager (handling of instruments, gases, cryogenics, resource management, storage of chemicals, waste management, etc).
- Experience in laboratory supplies management.

Desirable:

- Previous Knowledge/experience in a synthetic chemistry lab.
- Good command of the English language.
- Use of office 365 and database management.

Abilities:

- Ability to think and act strategically and proactively.
- Problem-solving aptitude.
- Teamwork, proactivity, and empathy.

Duration and start date:

1 year extendable. The candidate is expected to start not later than January 2025.
